Dear Parent/Carer,

As we move into the winter and the weather is changing, it is timely to remind all parents and carers of our adverse weather plans. We will prioritise the health and safety of all students and staff when making the decision to keep open or close the school alongside national guidance.

In the event of a partial or whole school closure, parents/carers will be notified via School Gateway, the school website and our social media channels as soon as the decision has been made.

We will also notify the Local Authority who advertise school closures on their website and social media accounts.

Remote form time

If the school has to close due to adverse weather, your child will be sent a Teams invite to a form time meeting with their form tutor to start at 9am. All students are expected to attend this meeting where a register will be called, key information passed on and notices provided. This meeting will run between 9-9.15am. Form time on Teams will take place each morning of any closure due to adverse weather.

All students have an Office 365 account and can access Teams via the link from the student link page on our website. Students will be expected to access their learning whilst working from home. This could include:

- Using Pearson Revise. Within this platform, all students (KS4) can access
 ebooks for the majority of their subjects and work through these alongside
 the mini assessment feature within the platform. Students can also create
 online flash cards using Pearson revise. The link to Pearson Revise is on our
